Resource distribution across the various asset classes

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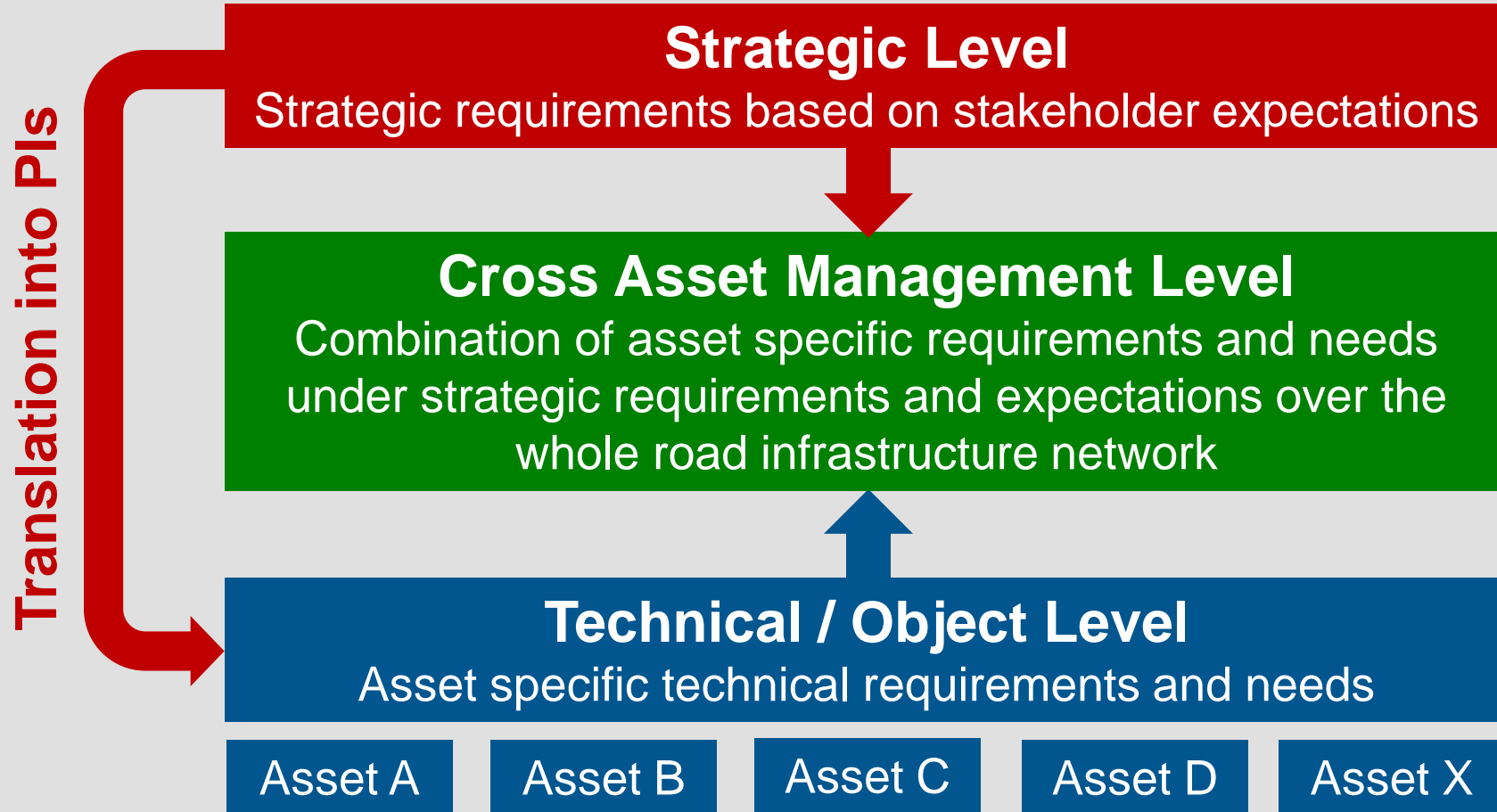
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Introduction

Resource distribution across the various asset classes leads to Cross Asset Management (X-AM)

- ▶ **X-AM** is a combination of management tasks and activities over different assets (pavements, engineering structures, road furniture, etc.)
- ▶ **X-AM** should be carried out within a pre-defined management process.
- ▶ **X-AM** tasks and activities can – to various degrees – have technical, economic, strategic and environmental objectives/considerations.
- ▶ A **X-AM** treatment strategy is a combination of asset specific maintenance treatment strategies over different assets in a pre-defined area or on a pre-defined road section within a given time period

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
